A Marist Sister for more than 60 years, Sister Simonne Ringuette touched the hearts of many people. It is to these people that we give voice as we attempt to pay tribute to our little sister who died on 3 February 2024 in Edmundston.

When everything was finished, she put everything back in order and left last. She did this for several years, week after week! It was great to see!
